1. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. Please complete the enclosed Team Entry Form and remit to the Organizing Committee by fax, mail or email:

All information must be received by the Organizing Committee no later than **5th of November 2005**.

VISA

To travel to China, you are required to have a **Visa**. Once we have your team entries, we will send a letter of invitation **by name**. This invitation by name is requirement when you make an application for a visa.

2. REGISTRATION

Station Changchun: The registration will take place daily starting on Saturday, December 12th, from 09:00- 17:00 at the official hotel in Changchun.

To be eligible for participation in the 2005 Freestyle FIS World Cup, each competitor must be a citizen of the country from the National Ski Association. He or she must have a license with and prove this with a valid passport. All fees and deposits must be paid in cash upon registration.

3. ACCOMMODATION

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half pension, each participant will pay the Organizing Committee the US dollar or Euro in cash equivalent of 45 Swiss Francs per day (according to the FIS Rate as set in the World Cup Rules).

Those athletes who wish to arrive early and require for accommodation before the dates mentioned above should contact the Organizing Committee as early as possible.



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The Organizing Committee will prepare lunch for the participants. Each lunch will cost 8 US dollars per person.

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

4. TRANSPORTATION

Please specify Changchun as your point of arrival. The Organizing Committee will help to arrange the pick-up at the Changchun airport.

The Organizing Committee will help to arrange send-off at Changchun airport.

The Organizing Committee will offer bus transportation that run daily from the venue to the hotel.

60 USD per person is charged for the service of transportation.

5. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. A 20 US dollars deposit per bib will be charged upon registration.

6. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Associations or Federations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

7. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision to local hospital in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

8. MEDICAL AND DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.

9. OTHER INFORMATION

Further information including official competition program, team leaders' meeting and etc. will be informed later.
