(Athletes, teams, FIS team, Swiss Timing and In Front TV)

To be accredited you need to

- **Provide results for:**
 - an RT-PCR nasal swab test <0 carried out less than 72h prior to arrival en site
 - or an Abott or Roche serological test >0 of less than 8 weeks
 - Or an RT-PCR nasal swab >0 of less than 3 months and more than 2 weeks
- **Fill in the FIS questionnaire enclosed**

During the races you can take

- **RT-PCR tests**
by appointment in groups for athlètes, coaches or persons staying in Val d'Isère between technical and speed races and for teams moving on to Val Gardena.
- **RT-PCR tests**
by appointment for symptomatic cases and by notification for contact cases

 - Or an RT-PCR nasal swab >0 less than 3 months and more than 2 weeks
- **Fill in the FIS questionnaire enclosed**

**Protocol to follow for:
Symptomatic cases – positive cases – contact cases**

Suspect cases:

Person showing typical symptoms =>

Inform the Medical Coordinator (red bubble) or Medival (other bubble)

1. Immediate quarantine in isolation room: Antigenic or RT-PCR test and teleconsultation
2. If antigenic test negative RT-PCR test must be carried out.
3. If RT-PCR test negative, possible to rejoin the event after a teleconsultation.
4. If RT-PCR test positive => 7 day quarantine + 2 days after symptoms disappear and possibility of rejoining the event after a teleconsultation and approval by the medical centre doctor

Asymptomatic person with a positive PCR or antigenic test

Immediate quarantine for 7 days. Possibility to rejoin the event depends on approval by the Medical Centre Doctor

Contact cases:
Identified by the ARS and/or the Covid 19 Task Force

1. Immediate quarantine in isolation room for 7 days and medical consultation (team doctor or doctor from medical centre).
2. If no symptoms => RT-PCR test 7 days later
 - Negative result: rejoin event.
 - Positive result: quarantine for 7 extra days
3. If symptoms => RT-PCR or antigenic test compulsory
 - If antigenic test negative => RT-PCR test
 - If second RT-PCR test negative => rejoin event
 - If test positive => 7 days quarantine + 2 days after symptoms disappear, rejoin event after teleconsultation and approval of medical centre doctor

Have you tested positive to the PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) test during the last 14 days?		

If there is evidence of an acute infection you must wear a mask, the medical personnel are equipped and isolation will be required. The local public health authority will be notified, and their protocols will be followed. An accreditation will not be issued until you have been cleared by the local public health authority. Athletes and accredited persons should be reassured that declaring travel from high risk area will not preclude participation, but that they should expect to be more closely monitored.

The personal information provided is treated strictly confidentially by the Local Organising Committee and FIS. It will only be used for the purpose of assessing whether the applicant can be granted or maintain accreditation in view of the COVID-19 outbreak. Local and global public health requirements will determine the length of time the data is retained.
