 - 1) if you can show a negative PCR test that is not older than 72 hours.
 - 2) if you have registered in the FIS Passport and answered all the questions there - please make the input until Thursday, 28.01.2021 at 04:00 pm
- The accreditations will be brought to the hotels in time (after checking the FIS Passport)
- In order to reduce contacts and comply with Corona regulations, we ask you to send us **an accreditation-compliant picture** of all team members (.jpg file; portrait photo with monochrome background). Thank you!

General information on PCR tests

In Titisee-Neustadt, only persons with a negative PCR test are allowed to enter the stadium (no exceptions have been approved by the authorities).

Masks are obligatory throughout the stadium (FFP-2 masks without valves, no bandanas).

According to the FIS regulation, each team member receives two FFP-2 masks (without valve) per day from the LOC.
