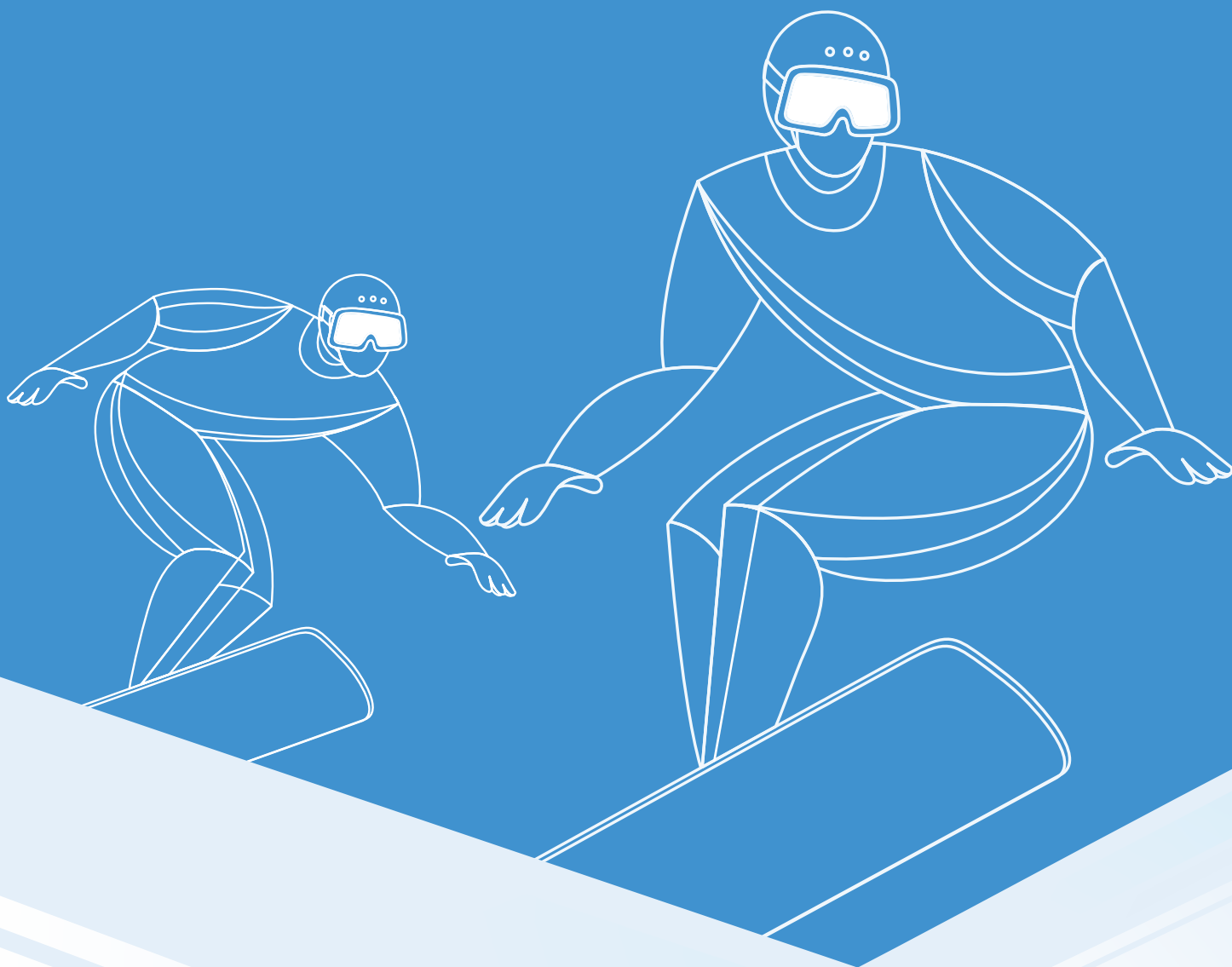

## **2. RULES**

- Georgian Ski Federation and Mountain Trails Agency are organizing two times Parallel Giant Slalom to be held in Bakuriani, Georgia on February 19th and 20th of February in Bakuriani ski resort, “Didveli” Mountain.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations
- This competition is a Parallel Giant Slalom events and is open to both men and women.
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The Organizing Committee reserves right to change the schedule depending on the snow conditions, weather or decision of the competition jury.

### 3. ENTRIES

- Entries will be accepted from the National Ski Associations in accordance with the FIS qualification quotas and rules. Please complete FIS entry form and send it to the OC by the email: [raceoffice@gsf.ge](mailto:raceoffice@gsf.ge)
- Entries must be sent to the Organizing Committee before Friday, 15th of January 2022.

### 4. REGISTRATION AND MEANS OF PAYMENT

- All teams are responsible to arrive and register at race office – located in Hotel “Crystal” before the first Team Captain’s meeting, February 18th.
- Accommodation with Half Board for the dates: 17 February - 20 March 2022 is 80 CHF per person per night.
- Participation Fee for all entered competitors of CHF 30 per official training, and competition day. Ski Passes for all coaches and technical staff is included in the athletes Entry Fee.
- Quotas for the coaches and technical staff are according to the FIS rules.
- Athletes must pay security deposit of EUR 20 in cash for the Bibs.

**Important Information: Please take into notice that only after paying the accommodation fee, teams will be able to get the accreditation.**

## 6. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSFER

- Participants are responsible for their own transportation fee. Bakuriani ski resort is located 190 km away from Tbilisi international airport, The OC offers transfers between the airport of Tbilisi and the resort (busses, mini vans for teams and trucks for equipment). Transfer requests are to be sent to office trifecta@gmail.com and should include the following information:
  1. Arrival/departure date, time, flight numbers, destination (from/to)
  2. Number of passengers and all names of participants in a group
  3. Amount of luggage in pieces and its approximate total weight.
- Transportation on site will be provided by the OC and will be free of charge.
- The accommodation and transfer request should be sent no later than 5th of February 2022
- Competitors, coaches and OC key staff will be accommodated in Hotel Crystal.

## 7. BIBS AND HELMETS

- It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets during the official training, competitions and award ceremony (Bib only).
- Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 20 Euros per bib. The deposit will be refunded at the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

## 8. LIABILITY

- All competitors, officials and other members of their National Association who attend or participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee: Georgian Ski Federation, Mountain Trails Agency, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by the competitors, officials or any other persons in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event.
- All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

## 9. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

- Every Competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee: Georgian ski Federation, Mountain Trails Agency and the FIS will not be held responsible for accidents or damaged equipment during the training and competition.

- Accident Protocol
  - In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical staff from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the Tbilisi Medical Centre or local hospital.
